Ardys Geneva Ingvalson (nee Omodt), 84, passed away into the arms of our Lord on March 8, 2019. She lived an amazing and exemplary life, full of love, compassion, service, and faith.

Born in Caledonia, MN, to Melvin and Regina Omodt in 1934, Ardys lived in Beaver Ridge outside of Caledonia in her formative years. After living most of her life in Spring Grove, MN, she moved to Waukon, IA, in her final year to be closer to daughters.
