Betty LorRayne (Sundet) Johnson passed into the eternal care of our Lord on Sunday, January 23rd, 2022 at home surrounded by her family.

She was born on December 10th, 1960 in Spring Grove, the daughter of Alden and Rose (Horgen) Sundet. Betty was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church in Spring Grove.

As a lifelong resident of Spring Grove, Betty attended K-12 at Spring Grove Public School. She also attended St. Cloud University where she graduated with a degree in Early Childhood Elementary Education.

She remained very involved even after her cancer diagnosis in February of 2016.
