



Daryel Wayne Bergsrud

July 5, 1940 - September 28, 2016

Daryel Wayne Bergsrud was born July 5, 1940 in Spring Grove, Minnesota, to Walter and Luverne (Bryant) Bergsrud. He was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church.

In his early years, Daryel worked at Ulven Drugs, Yellowstone National Park, and the Rochester Kahler Hotel. In 1969 he moved to Alaska and worked at Western Geophysical on the north slope. Later he was employed in Anchorage as chef for the Holy Spirit Retreat Center and in 2005 retired from the University of Alaska Commons.

After being diagnosed with Parkinson's he returned to Spring Grove in 2009 and lived at Spring Grove Assisted Living. He was an active member of Central Lutheran Church in Anchorage where he was in the church choir and when he returned to Spring Grove he joined Trinity Lutheran Church.

On Wednesday , September 28, 2016, at Tweeten Health Care of Spring Grove, Daryel passed into the eternal care of our Lord. He was 76 years old.

Daryel was survived by two sisters Berthana Wirth of Spring Grove, Minnesota and Lucinda Thomas of Four Oaks, North Carolina; one brother Wesley(Peggy) Bergsrud of Anchorage, Alaska; and many nieces, nephews, great and great-great nieces and nephews.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by one sister LaDean Dahle and one brother David Bergsrud.
