Doris "Dory" Belinda Dvergsten Lanswerk Hagen of Stewarville, MN, formerly of Spring Grove, MN, passed peacefully in her sleep on Tuesday, August 20, 2019 after a day filled with love from her children and their spouses, grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Dory was born December 18, 1922 at her home in Spring Grove, MN to Jorgena (Bjergum) and Julius Dvergsten. She attended Spring Grove Public High School, Winona Business College as well as Secretarial School in LaCrosse. Dory was a bank teller at Onsgard/Jennings State Bank for 23 years before retiring at age 69.
