November 18, 1925 - January 10, 2015

Glenn Delmar Morken, age 89, of Spring Grove passed away due to natural causes on Saturday, January 10, 2015 at Tweeten Lutheran Health Care in Spring Grove.

Glenn was born November 18, 1925 in Milwaukee, WI to Oscar & Cora (Wermager) Morken. He went to country school near Waterloo Ridge and graduated from Spring Grove High School.

He was a farmer for many years, until he married Evonne and moved to town. He started at Northern Engraving soon thereafter.

On June 27, 1970 he married Evonne (Treangen) Otterness at Waterloo Ridge Lutheran Church. They were blessed with two children, Lonnie & Joy. As a family, they enjoyed going on a few bus trips to Florida and loved to go out to eat on Friday nights. Glenn often had a smile on his face and enjoyed visiting with people. He took a genuine interest in other people and was always enthused to hear what others had been up to. He could be seen every morning drinking coffee at Cenex with his friends. He worked at Northern Engraving in Spring Grove for many years, most recently as a security guard. He held this position up until falling ill two weeks ago.

Glenn was a loyal supporter of both Lonnie & Joy's activities. He and Evonne were regular attendees at many sports events and music concerts during their children's years at Spring Grove Schools. They continued to support Spring Grove and Mabel-Canton extra-curricular activities long after their own

children graduated. He and Evonne were awarded "Booster of the Year" from Mabel-Canton schools for their faithful support of the school's athletics on May 19, 1998.

Glenn was a longtime member of Waterloo Ridge Lutheran Church and the Sons of Norway.

Glenn is survived by his wife, Evonne, of Spring Grove. He is also survived by his son Lonnie (Stephanie) of Mabel, and daughter Joy (Steve) Afdahl of Lakeville, as well as granddaughters Sadie, Sophia, and Sahara Morken, and Abby & Emily Afdahl. Glenn is also survived by stepchildren (and their families) Mike Otterness, Susan (Otterness) Erickson, and Diane Otterness. Glenn was preceded in death by his parents, and step-son Randy Otterness.
