Greta Jean Lockhart, age 92 of Brownsville, passed away Sunday, January 19th, at Tweeten Healthcare in Spring Grove.

She attended rural grade school near Waterville, IA, and graduated from Decorah High School in Decorah, IA

Greta went to Chicago after High School for employment and spent thirty seven years working as a secretary in both commerce and civil service. She worked in Kentucky, St. Paul, MN, and La Crosse, WI during those years. In La Crosse she was employed by the U.S. Forest Service and also by Trane Company. After moving to the Brownsville area, Greta owned and operated Spring Hills Trout Farm, and also had and antique business.

After retirement she pursued her love of the arts, in the form of painting landscapes and portraits, and weaving beautiful pieces on her looms in her studio.
